: SUBMISSION OF DATA ON PORT CAPACITY FOR CARGO CLEARANCE

Relative to BAI Memorandum Order No. 6 series of 2020 "Transitory Working Arrangement with the VQS South Harbor during the Temporary Closure of MICP" and BAI Memorandum Order No. 7 series of 2020 "Veterinary Quarantine Station Port Guidelines in Case of Diversion of Cargoes", all Veterinary Quarantine Stations processing international port arrivals are hereby required to submit data on your respective port capacity for cargo clearance in terms of facility and personnel.

Data on the volume (how many container vans, size of container vans) of daily cargo clearance (for both meat products and feed products) that can be handled by your respective port is needed to assist the BAI management on policy changes regarding solutions to port congestion during peacetime and crisis situations such as this COVID19 pandemic. Suggested matrix for data submission is shown below:
