SUBJECT : USE OF BAI ONLINE VERIFIER CHATBOT IN THE VERIFICATION OF ONLINE- ISSUED LOCAL SHIPPING PERMITS

To facilitate the verification of online-issued local shipping permits in the transport of live animals, animal products and by-products within the country, you are directed to utilize the BAI Online Verifier chatbot via Facebook messenger, at your respective checkpoints and stations. The active promotion and dissemination of its use to your LGU counterparts and other stakeholders are also enjoined.

The following instructions to access the BAI Online Verifier chatbot are provided for your information and guidance:

- 1. Open Facebook messenger application, and search BAI Online Verifier;
- 2. Select the "How to Verify?" message; there are three (3) options: NVQSD Shipping Permit, AWA Registration and Online Payment;
- 3. Select NVQSD Shipping Permit;
- 4. This auto message will appear with an instruction how to check NVQSD Shipping Permits; Send

You may also send a photo of barcode at the top-right corner portion of the shipping permit.

- 5. Click send message. An auto response generates the following information of existing application number:
 - a. Status

 - h. Category
 - i. Type
 - j. Quantity
