SUBJECT : GUIDELINES ON THE DISPOSITION OF IMPORTED DOGS AND CATS INTO THE PHILIPPINES WITH VIOLATION UNDER BAI MEMORANDUM CIRCULAR NO. 43, SERIES OF 2020 AND DA ADMINISTRATIVE CIRCULAR NO. 6, SERIES OF 2022

Pursuant to BAI Memorandum Circular No. 43, Series of 2020 "*Clarificatory Guidelines Re: Documentary Requirements and Other Important Matters in the Application for SPSIC in the Importation of Dogs and Cats, in line with Section III.A.2 of DA Administrative Order (AO) 9, Series of 2010*", and DA Administrative Circular No. 06, Series of 2022 "*Revised Rules and Regulations Governing the Importation of Agricultural and Fish and Fishery/Aquatic Products; Animal Feeds, Feed Ingredients and Feed Additives; and Fertilizers, Pesticides and other Agricultural Chemical Products into the Philippines*" the following guidelines on the disposition of imported dogs and cats into the Philippines found in violation of the above cited regulations are hereby issued:

A. DOCUMENTARY REQUIREMENTS FOR THE INSPECTION OF THE DOG/S AND/OR CAT/S UPON ARRIVAL AT THE PORT OF ENTRY

Upon arrival of the animal/s at any international port of entry, the importer shall present to the Veterinary Quarantine Officer (VQO) the following documents:

- Printed copy of Sanitary Phytosanitary Import Clearance (SPSIC).
- Original copy of Veterinary Health Certificate from the country of origin.
- Animal health information and identification indicating the breed, sex, medical record, and microchip number.

Any importer who fails to submit the above requirements, is deemed non-compliant and shall be processed in accordance with the subsequent provisions.

The importer is classified as follows in accordance with its purpose:

- ONE-TIME IMPORTER-** For companion/ guide, non-profit breeding, non-commercial purpose, one-time importer can import a maximum of three (3) animals (ex. 3 dogs or 2 dogs and 1 cat) at the same time, once in a year; OR maximum of 3 animals more than once a year, provided that the same animals are identified through its microchip numbers.

2. **WITH SERVICE/EMOTIONAL SUPPORT/THERAPY DOGS AND CATS** - subject to submission of a certification from the physician
3. **TOURIST STAYING LESS THAN 30 DAYS** - subject to submission of proof of itinerary and copy of return flight details.
4. **TRANSSHIPMENT** - subject to submission of proof of itinerary and copy of flight details.

B. SPECIFIC VIOLATIONS AND CORRESPONDING DISPOSITIONS

B.1 ONE-TIME IMPORTER

B.1.1. NO VALID SPSIC, NO VHC, NO VACCINATION RECORD

Option 1: Return to the country of origin

Option 2: Ship to a third country

Option 3: Mandatory 30-day quarantine in any of the BAI-registered boarding facilities¹

For Option 1 & 2:

1. Notice of Violation shall be issued by the Veterinary Quarantine Officer/Inspector to the importer.
2. The animal(s) will stay in the cargo facility or be transferred to a BAI registered facility while waiting for its re-exportation.
3. Proof of booking shall be presented to the Veterinary Quarantine Officer/Inspector at the port of exit prior to the release of the animal(s) in the cargo facility or BAI registered facility.
4. Affidavit of Undertaking shall be submitted by the importer to the Veterinary Quarantine Station or port of entry, as their first and final consideration to commit any violations stated in this Memorandum.
5. The importer is responsible for coordinating with the chosen Cargo facility or BAI-registered boarding facility¹, caretaking, and feeding during the quarantine, and transportation from the airport terminal/cargo to the boarding facility.
6. All expenses incurred shall be paid for by the importer.

For Option 3:

1. Notice of Violation shall be issued by the Veterinary Quarantine Officer/Inspector to the importer.
2. The animal(s) shall be subjected to mandatory anti-rabies and 5-in-1 vaccination not less than 14 days before the release from quarantine.

3. The importer is responsible for coordinating with the chosen BAI-registered boarding facility¹, transportation from the airport terminal/cargo to the boarding facility, caretaking, and feeding during the quarantine.
4. The importer shall bear all expenses incurred.
5. Aside from the mandatory quarantine, the importer must apply for a Sanitary and Phytosanitary Import Clearance (SPSIC) and shall pay the Inspection, SPSIC and permit fees before the animal(s) is released.
6. The BAI Veterinary Quarantine Officer/Inspector will issue a Liability Release Waiver² and will supervise the animal(s)' transfer.
7. Affidavit of Undertaking shall be submitted by the importer to the Veterinary Quarantine Station or port of entry, as their first and final consideration to commit any violations stated in this Memorandum.
8. A certificate of Notice of Quarantine Release for Dogs and Cats³ will be issued by the Veterinary Quarantine Officer/Inspector after completion of Option 3.

B.1.2. NO SPSIC (with VHC and VACCINATION RECORD)

Option 1: Return to the country of origin

Option 2: Ship to a third country

Option 3: Mandatory 14-day quarantine in any of the BAI-registered boarding facilities¹

For Option 1 & 2:

1. Notice of Violation shall be issued by the Veterinary Quarantine Officer/Inspector to the importer.
2. The animal(s) will stay in the cargo facility or be transferred to a BAI registered facility while waiting for its re-exportation.
3. Proof of booking shall be presented to the Veterinary Quarantine Officer/Inspector at the port of exit before the release of the animal(s) in the cargo facility or BAI registered facility.
4. Affidavit of Undertaking shall be submitted by the importer to the Veterinary Quarantine Station or port of entry, as their first and final consideration to commit any violations stated in this Memorandum.
5. The importer is responsible for coordinating with the chosen Cargo facility or BAI-registered boarding facility¹, caretaking, and feeding during the quarantine, and transportation from the airport terminal/cargo to the boarding facility.
6. All expenses incurred shall be paid by the importer.

For **Option 3**:

1. Notice of Violation shall be issued by the Veterinary Quarantine Officer/Inspector to the importer.
2. The importer is responsible for coordinating with the chosen BAI-registered facility¹, transportation from the airport terminal/cargo to the boarding facility, caretaking, and feeding during the quarantine.
3. The importer shall bear all expenses incurred.
4. Aside from the mandatory quarantine, the importer must apply for a Sanitary and Phytosanitary Import Clearance (SPSIC) and shall pay the Inspection, SPSIC and permit fees before the animal(s) is released.
5. The BAI Veterinary Quarantine Officer/Inspector will issue a Liability Release Waiver² and will supervise the animal(s)' transfer.
6. Affidavit of Undertaking shall be submitted by the importer to the Veterinary Quarantine Station or port of entry, as their first and final consideration to commit any violations stated in this Memorandum.
7. A certificate of Notice of Quarantine Release for Dogs and Cats³ will be issued by the Veterinary Quarantine Officer/Inspector after completion of Option 3.

B.1.3. NO MICROCHIP or MISMATCHED MICROCHIP

Option 1: Return to the country of origin

Option 2: Ship to a third country

Option 3: Mandatory thirty (30)-day quarantine in any of the BAI-registered boarding facilities¹

If the importer chooses **Option 3**, they are responsible for the following:

1. Notice of Violation shall be issued by the Veterinary Quarantine Officer/Inspector to the importer.
2. Coordinating with the chosen BAI-registered facility¹, transportation from the airport terminal/cargo to the boarding facility, caretaking, and feeding during the quarantine.
3. The importer shall bear all expenses incurred.
4. The animal(s) shall be subjected to mandatory microchip implantation prior to the release from the BAI-registered facility. Any expense likewise shall be borne by the importer.
5. The BAI Veterinary Quarantine Officer/Inspector will issue a Liability Release Waiver and will supervise the animal(s)' transfer.

6. Affidavit of Undertaking shall be submitted by the importer to the Veterinary Quarantine Station or port of entry, as their first and final consideration to commit any violations stated in this Memorandum.
7. A certificate of Notice of Quarantine Release for Dogs and Cats³ will be issued by the Veterinary Quarantine Officer/Inspector after completion of Option 3.

B.1.4. NO VHC (with SPSIC and VACCINATION RECORD)

Option 1: Return to the country of origin

Option 2: Ship to a third country

Option 3: Mandatory fourteen (14)-day quarantine in any of the BAI-registered boarding facilities¹

Option 4: Provide the VHC issued by the competent veterinary authority of the exporting country within forty-eight(48) hours (through email) and within seven (7) days (original copy). While waiting for the Veterinary Health Certificate (VHC), the animal(s) will be transferred to the BAI- registered boarding facility¹.

For Option 3:

1. Notice of Violation shall be issued by the Veterinary Quarantine Officer/Inspector to the importer.
2. The importer is responsible for coordinating with the chosen BAI-registered facility¹, transportation from the airport terminal/cargo to the boarding facility, caretaking, and feeding during the quarantine and the payment of all incurred expenses.
3. The BAI Veterinary Quarantine Officer/Inspector will issue a Liability Release Waiver² and will supervise the animal(s)' transfer.
4. Affidavit of Undertaking shall be submitted by the importer to the Veterinary Quarantine Station or port of entry, as their first and final consideration to commit any violations stated in this Memorandum.
5. A certificate of Notice of Quarantine Release for Dogs and Cats³ will be issued by the Veterinary Quarantine Officer/Inspector after completion of Option 3.

For Option 4:

1. Notice of Violation shall be issued by the Veterinary Quarantine Officer/Inspector to the importer.
2. The importer shall be responsible for coordinating with the competent veterinary authority of the exporting country for the issuance of the VHC. While waiting for the VHC they shall also be in charge of booking

with the BAI-registered facility, transportation from the airport terminal/cargo to the boarding facility, caretaking, and feeding during the quarantine.

3. The importer shall bear all expenses incurred.
4. The BAI Veterinary Quarantine Officer/Inspector will issue a Liability Release Waiver² and will supervise the animal(s)' transfer.
5. Affidavit of Undertaking shall be submitted by the importer to the Veterinary Quarantine Station or port of entry, as their first and final consideration to commit any violations stated in this Memorandum.

B.2 SERVICE/EMOTIONAL SUPPORT/THERAPY DOGS AND CATS

1. Notice of Violation shall be issued by the Veterinary Quarantine Officer/Inspector to the importer.
2. The importer must submit a certification that the animal is a service/therapy animal certified by a physician.
3. In addition, the importer must apply for a Sanitary and Phytosanitary Import Clearance (SPSIC) and shall pay the Inspection, SPSIC and permit fees before the animal(s) is released.
4. In the absence of updated veterinary record/s, the animal is required to undergo quarantine and receive the required vaccination and treatment for internal and external parasites.
5. In case the animal/s has no microchip number, the animal(s) shall be subjected to mandatory microchip implantation prior to the release of the animal(s).

B.3 TOURIST STAYING LESS THAN 30 DAYS

B.3.1. NO SPSIC, NO VHC, NO VACCINATION RECORD

Option 1: Return to the country of origin

Option 2: Ship to a third country

Option 3: The animal(s) will be held in a BAI-registered boarding facility¹. The importer/tourist shall be responsible for coordinating with the facility and providing the needs of the animal(s). All expenses shall be borne by the importer/tourist.

Option 1 or Option 2:

1. Notice of Violation shall be issued by the Veterinary Quarantine Officer/Inspector to the importer.

2. The importer is responsible for coordinating with the competent veterinary authorities of the receiving country to confirm the requirements, documents, and required test.
3. The importer shall bear all expenses incurred.

Option 3:

1. Notice of Violation shall be issued by the Veterinary Quarantine Officer/Inspector to the importer.
2. The importer is responsible for coordinating with the chosen BAI-registered boarding facility¹, transportation from the airport terminal/cargo to the boarding facility, caretaking, and feeding during the quarantine.
3. The importer shall bear all expenses incurred.
4. The BAI Veterinary Quarantine Officer/Inspector will issue a Liability Release Waiver² and will supervise the animal(s)' transfer.

B.4. TRANSSHIPMENT

Option 1: Return to the country of origin

Option 2: Ship to a third country

Option 3: Mandatory quarantine (depending on the violation/s - refer above mentioned violations)

Option 3:

1. Notice of Violation shall be issued by the Veterinary Quarantine Officer/Inspector to the importer.
2. The animal/s shall undergo a quarantine period at the BAI registered facility of final destination or at the declared quarantine site of the importer.
3. The VQS port of entry shall coordinate with the VQS final destination.
4. The VQS at the final destination shall supervise the animal/s during the quarantine period.
5. The VQS port of entry will issue a Liability Release Waiver² and will supervise the animal(s)' transfer.
6. Affidavit of Undertaking shall be submitted by the importer to the Veterinary Quarantine Station or port of entry, as their first and final consideration to commit any violations stated in this Memorandum.
7. A certificate of Notice of Quarantine Release for Dogs and Cats³ will be issued by the Veterinary Quarantine Officer/Inspector after completion of Option 3.
