#### MEMORANDUM CIRCULAR

No. 45 Series of 2023

SUBJECT:

REITERATION OF THE REQUIREMENTS FOR THE LOCAL MOVEMENT OF

MEAT AND PROCESSED MEAT PRODUCTS

WHEREAS, Department of Agriculture (DA) Administrative Order (AO) no. 5 series of 2019 provides guidelines on the shipment of live animals, animal products and by-products departing from seaport or airport and/or pass through established interregional veterinary quarantine checkpoints with the Philippines, and Section 6.4 states that shipping permits shall no longer be a requirement for cooked processed meat and egg products (including but not limited to liquid egg, powdered egg), except for pork as per DA Administrative Circular (AC) no. 2 series of 2022;

WHEREAS, DA Administrative Circular (AC) no. 2 series of 2022 specifies the documentary requirements for pork and pork products relative to the National Zoning and Movement Plan for the Prevention and Control of African Swine Fever:

WHEREAS, Republic Act No.11032, or the Ease of Doing Business and Efficient Government Service Delivery Act of 2018 directs government offices to evaluate and streamline its regulatory processes;

NOW THEREFORE, the issuance of local shipping permit requirements for uncooked and cooked processed meat products is hereby reiterated, to ensure the equitable implementation of DA AO No.05 s.2019 and DA AC no. 02 s.2022, the following requirements for the local movement of processed meat products are hereby reiterated:

#### A. PORK AND PROCESSED PORK PRODUCTS
